## RCM Report Southern Piedmont Area NA May 19 2024

I attended the April 27 meeting of the NC Region of N.A. via Zoom. The meeting was held in Greenville, NC. The meeting began with a discussion of current vacancies among Region Officers. These including Vice Chair, Alternate Secretary, Alternate Treasurer, Alternate H&I Chair, Alternate PR Chair, Alternate Policy Chair and Outreach Coordinator. It was also noted that Unicorn P, who has served as Region Chair for several years, will be resigning at the end of the next meeting in June somewhere in the Foothills Area.

The board resolved to recruit for all the vacancies, especially the Chairman's post, over the next three months. Which is why I mention this in case any SPANA Officers or GSRs might be interested.

The Treasurer's Report followed. It was highly complicated and a copy of the detailed report of many pages is included in the minutes I have attached to this report. After taking in \$4371.92 from home groups and other donations since the January meeting the region treasury was at \$9,636.76. But after the Treasurer sent checks for \$3,475.32 (75% of the collection) to NA World Service and \$1,161.44 to send a delegate to the Southeastern Zonal Forum, the NC Region prudent reserve of \$5,000 was retained.

The Public Information (now Public Relations) report was submitted and included was a request to change PI to PR. That was approved by the Board and the RCMs. A copy of the PR report is also attached.

Area Reports were then read. There are 11 Areas in the Region and 10 RCMs were either present in person or via Zoom. A copy of my reports as well as those from the other Areas is also included in the minutes package attached.

The group also discussed the then upcoming Grandfather Mountain NA Camping Retreat to be held May 15-20. A number of board members as well as RCMs stated plans to attend the retreat which ends tomorrow.

A new NC Region Service Committee Policy Handbook was also reviewed and approved. A copy of the new handbook is also in the Region minutes attached.

Finally a CaroliNAs Multi-Regional Service Symposium co-hosted by the NC and Carolina Regions is slated for September 28 from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. at the Weddington United Methodist Church Youth Center in Weddington, NC near Charlotte. The symposium will offer training for a variety of NA service positions. Anyone interested in attending can contact Brian C (919-274-2353) or Rich W (704-497-0396) for more information, including lodging. A flyer and more information about the symposium is also included in the Region minutes attached.
