Section VII - Elections

- a. Southern Piedmont Area elections are to be held annually in July at the regular SPASC meeting.
- b. Nominations will open in March prior to elections.
- c. Reminders will be placed in; SPASC minutes starting in February.
- d. Nominations must be submitted by the June SPASC meeting.
- e. All nominees must submit a written service resume on proper form and be present at the SPASC meeting to state their willingness.
- f. All positions, except chairperson, are open for nomination.
- g. The election of any SPASC officer is done by a roll call (home group) vote.
- h. A "vote of confidence" should be cast by the simple majority before the vice-chairperson, alternate treasurer, and the alternate secretary assume their respective positions. If simple majority is not obtained, then position is open for elections.
- i. In the event that a SPASC position is not filled at the annual election, the position remains open and nominations and service resumes will be accepted until that position is filled. (Refer to section IV-A Southern Piedmont Area Elections.)
- j. In case a position becomes open, alt. or vice-chair will be asked if they are willing to complete term. If alt. or vice-chair declines, position is open and elected servant will complete term.
- k. All persons Be present to state willingness to fill any position at area level before a vote to fill such position be taken for that person (Approved 7/18/10 motion # 19 Revised 7/17/18)who has a resume coming back from the home groups must be present at the ASC to state their willingness to serve when the vote comes back. The same applies for trusted servants who are to receive a vote of confidence

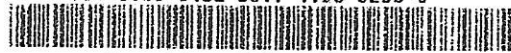
